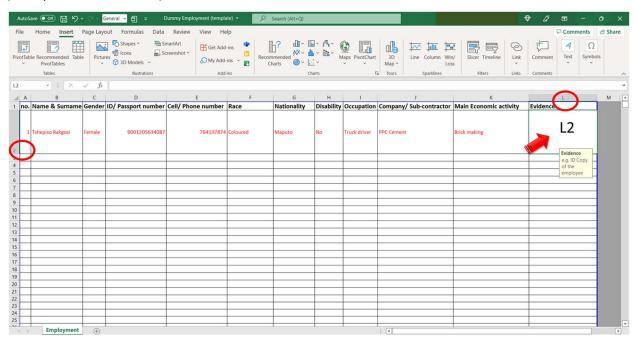


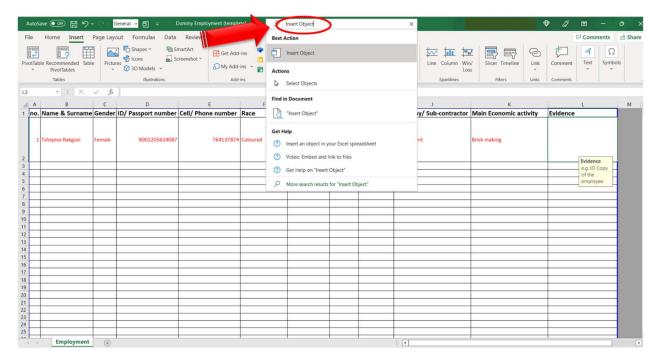
How to insert an object onto an Excel Spreadsheet:

Please follow the following steps:

Step 1: Click on Cell on spreadsheet where the document tab must be indicated when inserted. (Example Row 2 column L) **L2**

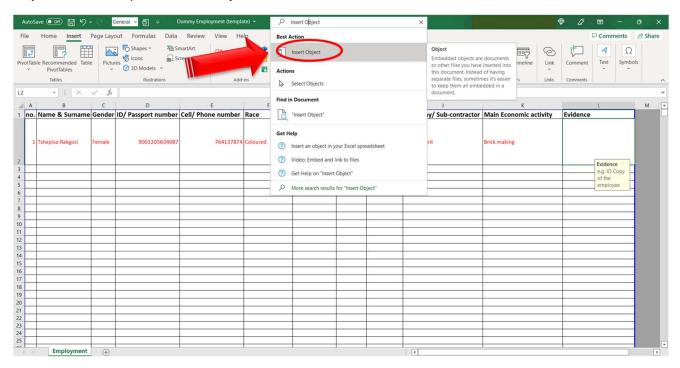


Step 2: Type in the help box the following: "Insert Object"

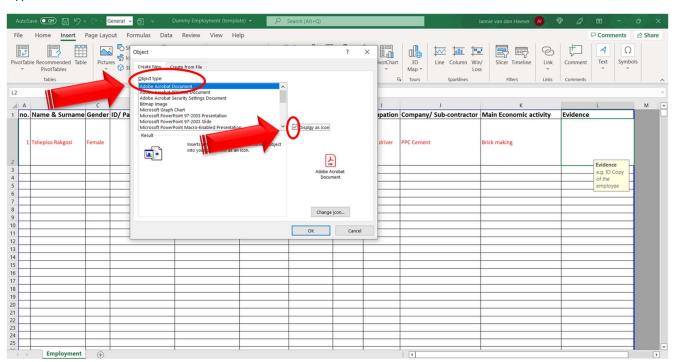




Step 3: Select the option: "Insert Object"

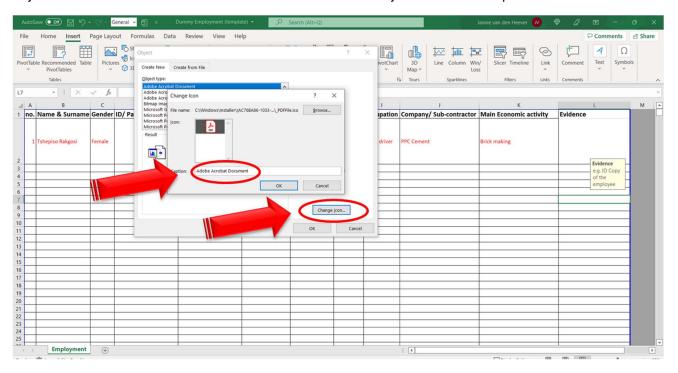


Step 4: Click on the tick box in order to select the "Display as Icon" and ensure that the: Object Type: is "Adobe Acrobat Document"

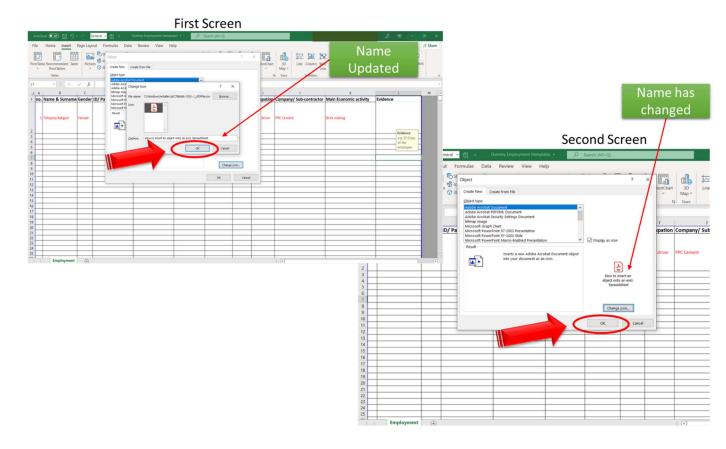




Step 5: Click on "Change icon" and capture the name of the PDF document you want to insert as an object. In this case the document name is: "How to insert an object onto an excl. spreadsheet".

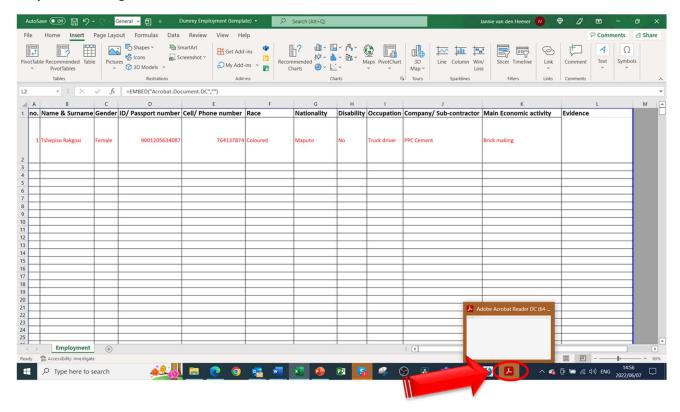


Step 6: After updating the name click on "OK" and click again on "OK" on the next screen.

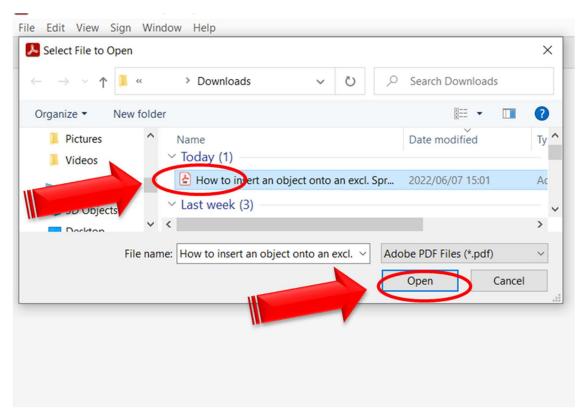




Step 7: On the right bottom of the screen an Adobe Acrobat Icon will flash. Click on the icon.

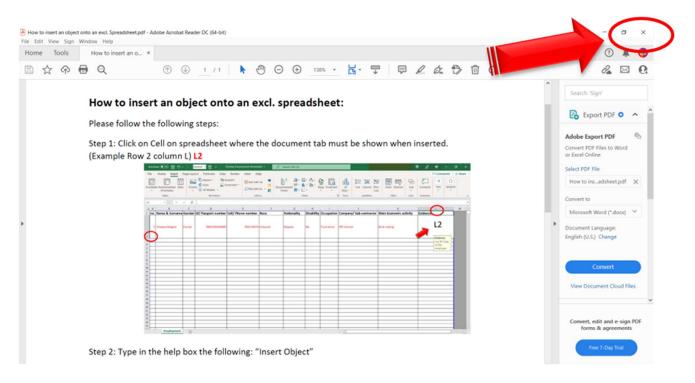


Step 8: Select document for upload on your explorer and click on open.





Step 9: Review to confirm that the correct document has been selected for upload. Close document by clicking top right of the screen the "X" to close.



Step 10: Document icon with name will be displayed in cell L2. Save excl. spreadsheet as normal. If you double click on the document icon the document will open.
